Can you share with us how you first got into modeling and what inspired you to pursue this career?

Additionally, navigating the business aspects of modeling, such as contracts and negotiations, also presented significant challenges. For overcome I started doing gym, making auditions videos, trying out new languages, scripts, dialogue delivery practice also what different I can act or show expressions. Making reels on any particular dialogue etc.

Could you tell us about a particular photoshoot or runway show that you consider a milestone in your modeling career?

Well I did photoshoots with very well known and talented photographers just like Mr. Radhakrishnan chakayat, Hemit modha. Also I never did any runaway show because I never got fit into runaway criteria. My height is 5'6 and its criteria for height is 5'9 5'12 for girls. Also I regret losing this opportunity. Definitely if ever I got the opportunity for runaway shows I will not miss it! Will do my best.

How do you prepare yourself mentally and physically for a major modeling

event <u>or p</u>hotoshoot?

Well I prepare myself mentally and physically for modeling or photoshoot like I do meditation I love listening to music and dance, or I keep reading something nice which will make my day also before going for shoot I cook my favourite things. So in mid of shoots I only consume coffee or fruits. Also the best thing is you can do is you can listen to calm music or anything like your favourite playlist. And photoshoot is something I honestly love and enjoy I play music whether I am shooting at home or studio my favourite playlist is on and I try to make different poses which will give photographer a best picture and next day I'll be in some international magazine. I always try to give best in every photoshoot or any modeling event. I do things from the heart. Rather getting frustrated rather using mind I use my heart to make that things a better.



Are there any specific goals you are aiming to achieve in your modeling career in the next few years?

Yes, definitely I want to be a successful actress in my life. I aspire to become a successful actress and create meaningful, impactful films that leave a lasting impression on people's hearts, ensuring that I am remembered for the positive mark I left on their lives.

What has been your most significant achievement in modeling so far, and

what did it mean to you?

My significant achievement for me was getting selected for multiple shoots at a time. In a day I used to do 6-7 shoots at a time. And getting selected from 30-40 models is a tough and rewarding opportunity I see. There are lot of people in a cue who is waiting for to get select. I am competition with myself I never seen myself comparing with anybody. I want to make a better version of myself and I am trying it each and everyday. Making better revolutions for myself everyday. I want to see myself successful.

How do you stay motivated and continue to grow in such a competitive industry?

Staying motivated is used to be hard in the beginning now I just feel like without any complaint or argument I will work hard on each and everything. So I started keeping my goals clear, maintaining healthy lifestyle, building strong network, keep myself focused and keep learning new things, celebrating small wins most important was staying professional and positive, making strong portfolio I used to take every type of shoots like food blogging travelling being a model I just not only explored things related to fashion but tried to put fashion in my other shoots as well. If I am shooting for some maharashtrian restaurant I am wearing marathi saree. I keep trying new and different things that makes sense, and you feel good when you apply your own knowledge and creativity to something.

How do you balance your professional modeling career with personal life and other interests?




This Independence Day, the Hindi box office is set to witness a fierce competition with three major releases: *Stree 2* starring Shraddha Kapoor, *Vedaa* featuring John Abraham, and Akshay Kumar's *Khel Khel Mein*. However, with the advance bookings now open, it appears that *Stree 2* is emerging as the clear frontrunner, leaving its competitors far behind.

In a remarkable achievement, *Stree 2* has already surpassed its predecessor's records. The original *Stree*, released in 2018, had an impressive opening day collection of Rs 6.82 crore and eventually grossed nearly Rs 130 crore during its theatrical run. In contrast, *Stree 2* has already exceeded these figures through advance bookings alone. According to Sacnilk, the horror-comedy sequel has sold over 2.21 lakh tickets, generating Rs 6.87 crore, and with two days remaining before its release, it is expected to easily surpass the Rs 10 crore mark.

The Maharashtra and Delhi circuits have been leading the charge in advance bookings, contributing Rs 1.87 crore and Rs 1.83 crore, respectively. *Stree 2* sees the return of the original cast, including Rajkummar Rao, Aparshakti Khurrana, Pankaj Tripathi, and Abhishek Banerjee, with a potential cameo by Akshay Kumar.

Stree 2 is part of Dinesh Vijan's expanding horror-comedy universe, which also includes *Bhediya* starring Varun Dhawan and Kriti Sanon, as well as the upcoming *Munjya* featuring Abhay Verma, Mona Singh, and Sharvari. The universe is set to grow even further with a vampire-themed installment starring Ayushmann Khurrana and Rashmika Mandanna.
