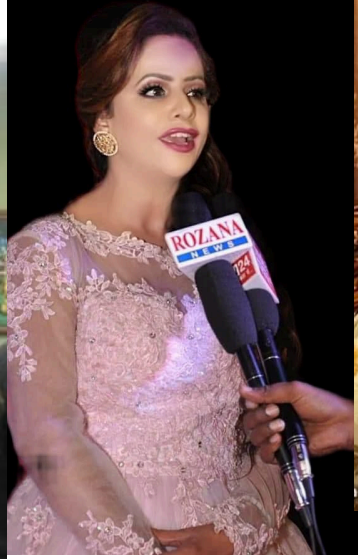

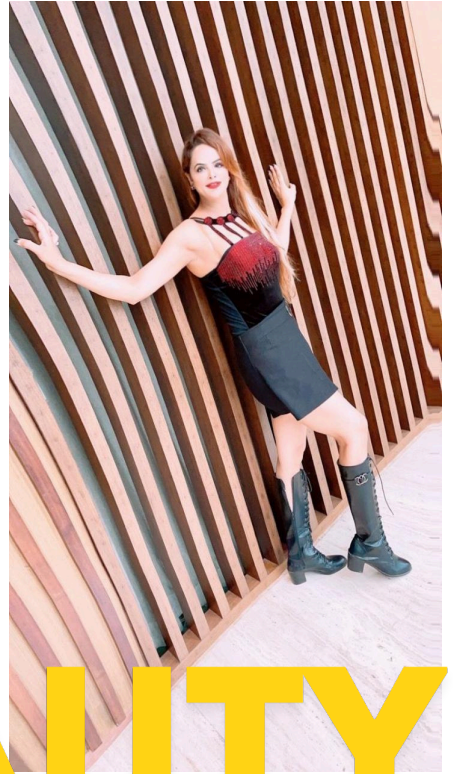

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What are the highlights of PM Modi's speech on 78th Independence Day?

PM Narendra Modi pitched for implementation of a Uniform Civil Code, which he referred to as secular civil code in his Independence Day speech. He said he feels the outrage over atrocities against women and also expressed concern over political unrest in Bangladesh, particularly safety of Hindu minorities. He said India has to come forward for "one nation, one election".

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PM Modi announces 75,000 new seats in Indian medical colleges in next 5 years

PM Narendra Modi, during his Independence Day speech on Thursday, said, "In the next five years, 75,000 new seats will be created in medical colleges in India." He said the announcement was being made as around 25,000 Indian students were going abroad every year to pursue medical education. He also said that "Viksit Bharat 2047 should also be 'Swasth Bharat'".

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India is in its golden era, we shouldn't let this opportunity go: PM Modi at Red Fort

In his Independence Day speech at Red Fort, PM Narendra Modi said, "I would like to say that this is a golden era for India," adding, "We should not let this opportunity go to waste." The PM also said that India's youth "does not intend to walk slowly" but "is in the mood to take a leap".

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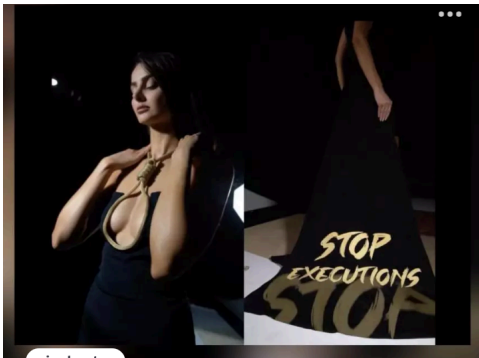


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Tarun Tahiliani uses his own logo in India's Olympics dress design, criticised

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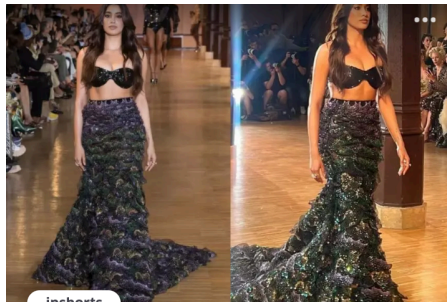


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Iranian model wears dress with noose around her neck at Cannes
